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The Commonwealth of Virginia Learning Center (COVLC)

The Commonwealth of Virginia Learning Center is Virginia's learning management system (LMS) and is a free staff training resource to provider agencies operating within Virginia.

The COVLC or VLC is a web-based application which can be accessed 24 hours a day – 7 days a week. The VLC delivers self-study training topics to the desktop, tracks progress throughout the training, and offers a certificate after completing a quiz to verify competency.
